

## Victorian Tenpin Bowling Association Inc (TBAV) – State Awards

CATEGORY	CRITERIA
<b>Junior Male Bowler of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a male junior (as defined by TBA) and eligible to represent Victoria in 2014. Performance based award.
<b>Junior Female Bowler of the year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a female junior (as defined by TBA) and eligible to represent Victoria in 2014. Performance based award.
<b>Youth Male Bowler of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a male youth (as defined by TBA) and eligible to represent Victoria in 2014. Performance based award.
<b>Youth Female Bowler of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a female youth (as defined by TBA) and eligible to represent Victoria in 2014. Performance based award.
<b>Senior Male Bowler of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a male senior (as defined by TBA) and eligible to represent Victoria in 2014. Performance based award.
<b>Senior Female Bowler of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a female senior (as defined by TBA) and eligible to represent Victoria in 2014. Performance based award.
<b>Adult Male Bowler of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a male adult (as defined by TBA) and eligible to represent Victoria in 2014. Performance based award.
<b>Adult Female Bowler of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a female adult (as defined by TBA) and eligible to represent Victoria in 2014. Performance based award.
<b>Bowler with a Disability of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a bowler with a disability (as defined by TBA) and eligible to represent Victoria in 2014. Performance based award.
<b>Representative Team of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a representative team competing at local, state, national or international level, residing in the jurisdiction of Victoria in 2014. Performance based award.
<b>Coach of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be a TBA registered coach residing in the jurisdiction of Victoria in 2014. Coaching either on an individual and/or team basis. Performance based award.
<b>Volunteer of the Year.</b>	Committee decision. Must be residing in the jurisdiction of Victoria in 2014 and be volunteering their time to areas that will benefit bowlers of Victoria.
<b>Directors Award.</b>	Committee decision. Must be residing in the jurisdiction of Victoria in 2014. This category is open to all divisions of bowlers regardless of average, age or sex. Performance based award.
<b>VicTenpins Gold Award.</b>	Popular nomination. Committee decision. A person who has contributed most to tenpin bowling in Victoria in 2014. The contribution could be by way of performances on the bowling lanes, contributions on a committee, coaching, organization of tournaments or a significant event or any other contribution to Victorian tenpin bowling deemed significant.
